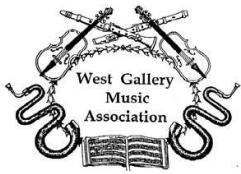
**A workshop of West Gallery Music hosted by Amber Valley Quire on behalf of WGMA.
