We hope that many members of the WGMA will join us for a big Zoom sing of lots of favourite carols, recorded over 27 years of concerts, workshops and rehearsals. Can you remember being at any of these events? Can you pick out your voice or instrument? Feel free to invite your friends and choir colleagues. Note some discrepancies: 656a 3rd verse takes the same words in reverse order; 144 No symphony, since it was recorded before it was written; 862 was recorded in F, so instruments need the music, but singers can sing from the book where it is Eb; 712 was sung very slowly, and we'll speed up the playback; 602a was led by tenors, but some editions of the music give the air to sopranos; RGW Hark the herald was sung to two very similar settings, but we've only given you one; some other pieces may have symphonies added or omitted.
